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**FINAL ORDER**

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This matter was brought before the Kentucky Board of Licensure for Massage Therapy (hereinafter referred to as “the Board”) on February 23, 2016 in a Notice of Hearing on a revocation of license for Respondent Jason Bui. The Board had received notice that Respondent had been convicted of a criminal offense relating to the practice of Massage Therapy in Fayette Circuit Court. The Board was also notified that Respondent had a warrant issued for his arrest by the Fayette District Court that was in effect as of Friday, April 15, 2016. The Board was notified on Friday, April 15 that a Recommended Order for default was mailed to Respondent. No exceptions to that recommended order have been filed with the agency head. Therefore, the Board hereby ORDERS as follows:


(1) The Hearing Officer’s Recommended Order of Dismissal issued on or about April 15, 2016 is hereby **ADOPTED**; and

(2) The Board hereby **Revokes** the Massage Therapy License issued to Respondent under license number 4639 due to conviction of a criminal offense relating to the practice of massage therapy; and

(3) Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of Five Hundred (\$500) dollars

within sixty (60) days of receipt of this final order.


